

### **Cleaner (Environmental Services Worker)**

The Housekeeping Program is responsible for the facilitation of cleanliness for the entire hospital. This role is integral to the health and well-being of our patients and staff. This individual will be part of a busy department that provides the highest quality of cleanliness to all areas of the hospital. This role is responsible for cleaning of various support service areas including scouring, scrubbing, mopping, polishing, using germicides, wet dusting and vacuuming. You will wash walls, ceilings, lights, vents, doors, windows and frames and the processing of Hospital waste. The physical demands of the role may include but are not limited to sitting, standing, walking, pushing, pulling, lifting, bending and repetitive actions. This position is to work all shifts especially weekends and holidays. This position contributes to ensuring there is a safe environment for patients, staff and visitors.

- Successful completion of secondary school required
- Two years current experience within an environmental services position, specifically cleaning required
- Current experience within a hospital environment preferred
