Dear Health Care Provider,

The Pain Clinic at Cambridge Memorial Hospital can offer patients assessment and treatment for chronic pain. You are welcome to refer all types of patients with chronic pain to this clinic. These include, but are not limited to:

- Patients with post-spinal surgical chronic pain
- Post surgical chronic pain
- Chronic non-cancer pain after failed pharmaceutical intervention
- Some sub-acute pain like rib fractures, whiplash, and shingles
- Post nerve-injury pain
- Cancer pain for palliation
- Joint pain from arthritis, etc.

Please note, this clinic does not prescribe narcotics or adjuvants. This is an Interventional Pain Clinic providing injection treatments. Services provided include:

- Various types of nerve blocks including peripheral nerve blocks, paravertebral blocks, stellate ganglion blocks, intercostal blocks, trigger point injections, etc.
- Epidural steroid injections
- Joint injections including hip, knee, shoulder, facet joints, etc.
- Ultrasound guidance is also available

Upon receipt of referral, patients will be seen by the next available physician. Our current wait time is 6 to 8 months. If you have any urgent patient concerns, please call one of our physicians to discuss setting up an urgent appointment.

With your referral, please provide patient demographics, chief complaints, medical history, a list of current medications, and any relevant investigations - particularly relevant imaging.

Patients will be contacted directly, by phone, with an appointment date and time. We do request 48 hours notice prior to a cancelled appointment.

Thank you for referring your patients to the Pain Clinic and for giving us the opportunity to participate in their care.
